The City of Monrovia CDBC Residential Rehabilitation Program provides grants to qualified low-moderate income homeowners of single-family detached homes to make needed home improvements including: code deficiencies, new roof replacement/repairs, ADA accessibility, water heater replacement, and more eligible health and safety improvements. Funding availability is limited and not guaranteed, residency and other restrictions apply.

HOW TO DETERMINE IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE

- Eligible Areas Residents residing in a single-family dwelling located within the incorporated boundaries of the City of Monrovia. Residents living in unincorporated areas of Monrovia, please visit <u>211LA</u> for additional resources.
- Eligible Income Annual household income does not exceed the <u>U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development</u> (HUD) established "Low-Moderate Income" limits shown on the next page. Gross family income includes all income from all family members living in the household.
- Step 1: Submit form via email during program opening timeframe
 - Completed and signed <u>Eligibility Intake Form</u> submitted via email to <u>map@ci.monrovia.ca.us</u>
 - Due to the amount of forms received and extensive time needed to review each form, reviews will be conducted as they come in on a first come, first serve basis.
- Step 2: If notified by City staff to move forward, the following will be requested for submission and consideration:
 - Fill and complete application packet
 - Copy of income tax forms for 2022
 - Copy of income verification documentation this includes the three (3) months of the most recent consecutive...
 - Payroll stubs
 - Social Security (SSI) checks
 - Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) checks
 - Pension and retirement checks
 - Alimony and child support payments
 - OR other income documentation from all other income sources, for all members of the household
 - o Copy of asset verification documentation
 - Copy of photo identification for all members in the household
