MARCH NEIGHBORHOOD TREASURE BLOCK PARTY





HIGHLIGHTING DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS AND DIVISIONS GIVES US THE OPPORTUNITY TO SHARE WHAT THEY HAVE BEEN WORKING ON AND HOW THEY ARE PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE. SO, CATCH UP WITH THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE AND SEE WHAT IS HAPPENING!



CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE

THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE IS AN INTERNAL RESOURCE TO ALL OPERATING DEPARTMENT, OFFERING SUPPORT AND PROBLEM-SOLVING. WITH A TEAMWORK MENTALITY, THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE IS DEDICATED TO SERVING THE COMMUNITY THROUGH SERVING EACH OTHER.

THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE CONSISTS OF THREE DIVISIONS WITH A TOTAL OF 12 FULL TIME EMPLOYEES AND 2 PART TIME EMPLOYEES.

CITY CLERK'S OFFICE

IF YOU ASK SOMEONE ON THE STREET WHAT THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE DOES, MOST OF THE TIME YOU'LL HEAR THINGS LIKE ISSUE BIRTH CERTIFICATES AND MARRIAGE LICENSES, OR "THAT'S WHERE YOU GET COURT RECORDS." FUNNILY ENOUGH, WE DON'T HANDLE ANY OF THOSE, AND WHAT FALLS UNDER THE CITY CLERK UMBRELLA CAN VARY GREATLY DEPENDING ON THE CITY; TO LIST THEM ALL HERE WOULD MAKE GREAT READING MATERIAL FOR SLEEPLESS NIGHTS, SO WE'LL PROVIDE SOME HIGHLIGHTS INSTEAD. OF COURSE, WE COORDINATE CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS AND HOLD ALL THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF THE CITY (INCLUDING ORIGINAL MINUTES, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS DATING ALL THE WAY BACK TO 1887). OUR LOCAL ELECTIONS ARE CONDUCTED BY THE COUNTY NOW, BUT WE STILL FACILITATE THE ENTIRE CANDIDATE PROCESS AND COORDINATE CLOSELY WITH OUR COUNTY PARTNERS ON THINGS LIKE VOTER EDUCATION, VOTE CENTER LOCATIONS, AND BALLOT DROP BOXES. DID YOU KNOW THAT THE OFFICIAL BALLOT DROP BOX AT THE LIBRARY COLLECTED OVER 9,500 BALLOTS FOR THE NOVEMBER ELECTION? MONROVIA LEADING ONCE AGAIN WITH ONE OF THE HIGHEST IN THE REGION! WHEN THE PANDEMIC BROUGHT THE WORLD TO A SCREECHING HALT, IT SEEMED LIKE A TIME TAKE A BREATH AND CATCH UP - BOY WERE WE WRONG. IN 2020, OUR TEAM TOOK THE LEAD ON CENSUS 2020 OUTREACH (WITH AN EVER-CHANGING DEADLINE), PROCESSED ALMOST 1000 PUBLIC RECORD REQUESTS IN 2021, AND CONTINUED TO HANDLE SUBPOENAS, CLAIMS, CONTRACTS, INSURANCE TRACKING, PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS, AND THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS FOR BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, TO NAME A FEW.

HUMAN RESOURCES

AS COMMUNITY MEMBERS OF MONROVIA, YOU ALREADY KNOW THAT IT'S A WONDERFUL PLACE TO LIVE AND RECREATE. HOWEVER, MONROVIA IS ALSO A GREAT PLACE TO WORK! IF YOU'RE INTERESTED IN JOINING THE CITY OF MONROVIA ORGANIZATION, HUMAN RESOURCES WILL MOST LIKELY BE THE FIRST DEPARTMENT THAT YOU'LL COME INTO CONTACT WITH. ANNUALLY, HUMAN RESOURCES WILL CONDUCT ABOUT 40 RECRUITMENTS AND ONBOARD NEARLY 70 NEW EMPLOYEES. IN ADDITION TO RECRUITING INDIVIDUALS, HUMAN RESOURCES IS ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR EVERYTHING THAT GOES ALONG WITH AN EMPLOYEE'S LIFE CYCLE, INCLUDING RETENTION, BENEFITS, TRAININGS, WELLNESS PROGRAMS AS WELL AS RISK MANAGEMENT. SERVING ON THE STAFF FOR THE CITY OF MONROVIA ARE 250 FULL TIME EMPLOYEES AND OVER 60 PART TIME EMPLOYEES OF DIVERSE EXPERIENCES AND BACKGROUNDS.

ADMINISTRATION

THE ADMINISTRATION DIVISION WEARS MANY DIFFERENT HATS AND HAS A VERY FLEXIBLE RANGE OF RESPONSIBILITIES THAT SPAN FROM OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, PUBLIC INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS AND FOR THINGS THAT DON'T REALLY FIT INTO ANY CATEGORY, SPECIAL PROJECTS.

IN MONROVIA, WE PRIDE OURSELVES ON THE PROVIDING INFORMATION AND ENGAGING WITH THE COMMUNITY, WHICH IS WHY IT IS ONE OF THE HIGHEST PRIORITIES OF THE ADMINISTRATION TEAM. WHEN THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS LEARN SOMETHING THAT WE BELIEVE MAY AFFECT OUR RESIDENTS, VISITORS, OR BUSINESSES, IT'S OUR JOB TO RESEARCH AND SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH THE PUBLIC THROUGH ALL OF OUR CHANNELS FROM THE CITY WEBSITE, THE CITY MANAGER'S UPDATE TO SOCIAL MEDIA PLATFORMS. FOR EXAMPLE, WITH THE RECENT BOBCAT FIRE, AND MAJOR RAIN AND WIND EVENTS, WE USE ALL OF OUR VARIOUS PLATFORMS TO ENSURE THAT THE PUBLIC—YOU!—HAVE A PLACE TO FIND THE MOST UP-TO-DATE INFORMATION AND ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE. INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY IS ANOTHER ARM OF ADMINISTRATION THAT ALLOWS CITY STAFF TO DO THEIR JOB AS WELL AS PROVIDE RESOURCES FOR THE PUBLIC. DIDY YOU KNOW THAT WE RECENTLY EXPANDED OUR WI-FI SERVICE AT THE MONROVIA PUBLIC LIBRARY? WE'RE ALSO WORKING HARD TO STRENGTHEN OUR WI-FI NETWORK AT PUBLIC FACILITIES AND EVEN AREAS LIKE CANYON PARK.

THAT'S THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE IN A NUTSHELL. WE SHARE INFORMATION THAT WILL IMPACT THE MONROVIA COMMUNITY AND OFFER SUPPORT AND PROBLEM SOLVING TO ALL THE OPERATING DEPARTMENTS – SO THEY CAN FOCUS ON SERVING YOU!

COMMUNITY ACTIVIST POLICING TIP

MPD OFFICERS ARE ON A COUNTINUOUS LOOKOUT FOR CRIMES AND SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY THAT MAY OCCUR IN YOUR AREA. THE PROBLEM OF BURGLARY IS A GROWING CONCERN, AND WE NEED YOUR HELP IN COMBATTING THIS CRIME OF OPPORTUNITY. BASIC SECURITY PRECAUTIONS CAN SIGNIFICANTLY REDUCE THE CRIME OF BURGLARY. BY BEING SECURITY CONSCIOUS AND USING SIMPLE STEPS TO SECURE YOUR HOME OR YOUR APARTMENT, THE NUMBER OF CRIMINAL INCIDENTS CAN BE GREATLY REDUCED. HOW CAN YOU PREVENT BURGLARY?

- CLOSE AND LOCK ALL ENTRANCE DOORS USING STRONG LOCKS AND SOLID DOORS
- ENSURE ALL WINDOWS ARE CLOSED AND LOCKED AND COVERED BY BLINDS OR SHADES
- KEEP ALL AREAS WELL-LIT AND LEAVE AMPLE EXTERIOR/INTERIOR LIGHTS ON
- INSTALL SECURITY CAMERAS AND EXTERIOR LIGHTING
- KEEP SECURITY GATES CLOSED
- BE OBSERVANT AND CALL THE POLICE (911) ON SUSPICIOUS PERSONS
- DO NOT ANNOUNCE YOUR ABSENCE WHEN ON VACATION

VACATION TIPS:

- USE AUTOMATIC TIMERS FOR EXTERNAL AND INTERNAL LIGHTS
- HAVE A NEIGHBOR DO THE FOLLOWING: PICK UP YOUR MAIL AND PACKAGES OR STOP MAIL COMPLETELY WITH THE POSTAL SERVICE
- REQUEST VACATION CHECKS FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT BY CALLING 626-256-8000

CODE ENFORCEMENT TIP!

CODE VIOLATION VERSUS CIVIL MATTER

A REVIEW OF WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DIFFERENT CONCERNS

IF YOU HAVE A CONCERN ABOUT A PROPERTY OR YOUR LIVING CONDITIONS, IT MIGHT BE HANDLED BY THE CODE ENFORCEMENT TEAM OR CIVILLY WITH YOUR LANDLORD OR NEIGHBOR. GENERALLY SPEAKING, CODE ENFORCEMENT REGULATES ADOPTED CODES IN THE MONROVIA MUNICIPAL CODE, CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODE, AND CALIFORNIA HEALTH & SAFETY CODE TO NAME A FEW. THESE CODES COVER A WIDE ARRAY OF ISSUES AT A PROPERTY. MONROVIA'S CODE ENFORCEMENT IS DEDICATED TO ENHANCING THE COMMUNITY AND ENSURING THAT RESIDENTS LIVE IN SAFE CONDITIONS.

COMMON CODE ENFORCEMENT VIOLATIONS THAT ARE INVESTIGATED INCLUDE:

- UNPERMITTED CONSTRUCTION
- JUNK, TRASH, & DEBRIS IN PUBLIC VIEW
- GREEN POOLS
- OVERGROWN OR DEAD VEGETATION
- ABANDONED VEHICLES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY (ON PUBLIC STREETS IS HANDLED BY PARKING ENFORCEMENT)
- ZONING VIOLATIONS
- SUBSTANDARD HOUSING LACK OF HEAT, LACK OF WATER, STRUCTURE IN DISREPAIR, ETC.



THERE ARE SOME ITEMS THAT MUST BE WORKED OUT BETWEEN A LANDLORD AND TENANT. THE BEST APPROACH IS TO COMMUNICATE RESPECTFULLY BETWEEN PARTIES AND EXPLAIN THE CONCERN. AVOID THREATS AND AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR. IF YOU ARE A TENANT, YOUR LANDLORD OR MANAGER HAS A RESPONSIBILITY TO PREVENT SUBSTANDARD LIVING CONDITIONS AND MAKE REPAIRS. WE ALWAYS ADVISE YOU TO REVIEW YOUR LEASE OR RENT CONTRACT AND SEEK LEGAL ADVICE BEFORE WITHHOLDING RENT OR TAKING ANY OTHER ACTION. YOU CAN CONTACT THE NEIGHBORHOOD LEGAL SERVICES OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY FOR FREE AT 1 (800) 433-6251. COMMON CONCERNS THAT SHOULD BE HANDLED BY YOU OR THE OWNER:

- LEAKING FIXTURES
- DIRTY FLOORS/CARPET
- ISSUES WITH DOORS
- MINOR VISIBLE MOLD AROUND KITCHEN OR BATHROOM
- CLOGGED PLUMBING
- GARAGE NOT WORKING



THERE ARE A FEW SITUATIONS THAT ARE HANDLED CIVILLY BETWEEN NEIGHBORS. THIS INVOLVES ISSUES NEAR THE PROPERTY LINE AND ANY PROPERTY DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE OTHER PROPERTY. AGAIN, POSITIVE AND CALM COMMUNICATION WITH YOUR NEIGHBOR IS THE BEST FIRST APPROACH. FEEL FREE TO SEEK LEGAL ADVICE AS WELL.

CODE VIOLATION VERSUS CIVIL MATTER

A REVIEW OF WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DIFFERENT CONCERNS

COMMON NEIGHBOR CONCERNS THAT ARE HANDLED CIVILLY:

- PROPERTY LINE FENCE OR WALL NEEDS TO BE REPAIRED/REPLACED THE CITY DOES NOT KNOW WHERE THE FENCE IS LOCATED (EITHER DIRECTLY ON THE PROPERTY LINE OR ON ONE SIDE) AND THEREFORE IT IS UP TO THE NEIGHBORS TO COORDINATE WHO NEEDS TO REPAIR IT.
- TREES OR HEDGES THAT HANG OVER THE PROPERTY LINE/FENCE A CANOPY OF A TREE CAN OVERHANG THE FENCE AND DROP LEAVES ON A NEIGHBORING PROPERTY. IT IS UP TO THE NEIGHBOR TO SEEK LEGAL ADVICE ABOUT TRIMMING IT BACK. GENERALLY, ANYTHING THAT OVERHANGS THE PROPERTY LINE CAN BE TRIMMED BACK AS LONG AS IT WILL NOT ADVERSELY AFFECT OR KILL THE TREE.



• PROPERTY DAMAGE - IF A NEIGHBOR BACKS THEIR CAR INTO YOUR FENCE OR OTHERWISE DAMAGES SOMETHING ON YOUR PROPERTY, THEN IT IS CIVIL. IT MIGHT BE COVERED BY THEIR AUTO OR HOME OWNERS INSURANCE.

MOLD IS UNIQUE IN HOW IT IS HANDLED. IN 2015, CALIFORNIA ADDED A SECTION TO THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE THAT STATES VISIBLE MOLD MUST BE REPAIRED BY THE LANDLORD. CODE ENFORCEMENT IS NOT TRAINED OR EQUIPPED TO KNOW THE SPECIES OF MOLD, BUT WOULD ADDRESS THE ROOT CAUSES OF MOLD. THIS COULD BE A LEAK IN THE WALLS OR A LACK OF VENTILATION. TENANTS SHOULD MAKE A REASONABLE ATTEMPT TO NOTIFY THE LANDLORD ABOUT VISIBLE MOLD AND REQUEST THAT IT BE REPAIRED. FROM SB 655 (2015) "THIS BILL WOULD SPECIFY THAT VISIBLE MOLD GROWTH, EXCEPTING MOLD THAT IS MINOR AND FOUND ON SURFACES THAT CAN ACCUMULATE MOISTURE AS PART OF THEIR PROPER AND INTENDED USE, IS A TYPE OF INADEQUATE SANITATION AND THEREFORE A SUBSTANDARD CONDITION. THE BILL WOULD DEFINE MOLD AS MICROSCOPIC ORGANISMS OR FUNGI THAT CAN GROW IN DAMP CONDITIONS IN THE INTERIOR OF A BUILDING. BY EXPANDING THE DEFINITION OF A CRIME, THIS BILL WOULD IMPOSE A STATE-MANDATED LOCAL PROGRAM."

MINOR MOLD FOUND NEAR BATHROOMS, SINKS, AND WINDOWS IS EXEMPT. THIS ADDRESSES VISIBLE MOLD THAT IS SUBSTANTIAL AND IN A LOCATION THAT IS NOT TYPICALLY MOIST LIKE A LIVING ROOM WALL OR CEILING. IF YOUR LANDLORD IS WILLING TO FIX ANY ISSUES IN YOUR HOME, LET THEM. THE GOAL AT THE END OF THE DAY IS TO RESOLVE THE ISSUE AND WORK TOGETHER.

WHILE CONDUCTING A DAILY SWEEP, OFFICER PINEDA OBSERVED GRAFFITI IN A RESIDENTIAL AREA. OFFICER PINEDA TOOK PICTURES OF THE GRAFFITI BECAUSE IT IS IN IN PUBLIC VIEW. OFFICER PINEDA OPENED A CASE AND SENT AN EDUCATION LETTER TO THE PROPERTY OWNERS INFORMING THEM OF THE VIOLATION. WHEN OFFICER PINEDA WENT BACK TO THE PROPERTY TO FOLLOW UP, THE VIOLATION HAD BEEN CLEANED UP. OFFICER PINEDA TOOK PICTURES AND CLOSED THE CASE.

NEIGHBORHOOD TIPS FOR SIDEWALK VENDORS

OUR NEIGHBORHOOD & BUSINESS SERVICES TEAM HAS RECEIVED INQUIRIES ABOUT SIDEWALK VENDORS AND FOOD TRUCKS. IN AN EFFORT TO HELP SHARE INFORMATION ABOUT THE REGULATIONS, WE HAVE LAUNCHED OUR FIRST NEIGHBORHOOD TIP ON "SIDEWALK VENDORS."

THE SIDEWALK VENDOR BILL (SB 946) TOOK EFFECT IN CALIFORNIA ON JANUARY 1, 2019.SB 946 MADE IT UNLAWFUL FOR LOCAL AGENCIES TO PROHIBIT SIDEWALK VENDORS FROM OPERATING IN THEIR CITIES. HOWEVER, SIDEWALK VENDORS ARE REQUIRED TO GET A CITY OF MONROVIA BUSINESS LICENSE AND SUBMIT A VALID LOS ANGELES COUNTY HEALTH PERMIT IF THEY SELL FOOD. THEY ARE ALLOWED, WITH THESE PERMITS, TO SET UP A STATIONARY STAND OR ROAM WITH CARTS AS LONG AS THEY FOLLOW MINOR RESTRICTIONS. FOOD TRUCKS AND TRAILERS ARE NOT COVERED UNDER "SIDEWALK VENDORS" AND HAVE DIFFERENT REQUIREMENTS. THEY ARE ALSO ALLOWED WITHIN THE CITY OF MONROVIA WITH THE PROPER PERMITS AND A CITY BUSINESS LICENSE.

CODE ENFORCEMENT HAS BEEN INTERACTING WITH DIFFERENT SIDEWALK VENDORS AND FOOD TRUCKS WITHIN THE CITY OF MONROVIA TO VERIFY THAT THEY HAVE PROPER PERMITS AND ARE NOT VIOLATING ANY OF THE RESTRICTIONS. SOME OF THE RESTRICTIONS INCLUDE: NO VENDING WITHIN 500 FEET OF A SCHOOL DURING SCHOOL OPERATIONS, STATIONARY VENDING IN A RESIDENTIAL ZONE IS PROHIBITED, NO LITTERING, AND NO BLOCKING OF ADA ACCESS ON SIDEWALKS.

MONROVIA SAMSON BEARS

SAMSON THE BEAR, ALSO KNOWN AS "THE HOT TUB BEAR" MADE HIS WAY INTO THE HEARTS OF MONROVIANS BY FREQUENTLY VISITING LOCAL RESIDENT'S HOT TUBS. IN 1994, AFTER SEVERAL MONTHS OF ENJOYING THE WARM WATERS OF A HOT TUB, HE BECAME ILL FROM INGESTING A PLASTIC BAG AND WAS THEN CAPTURED BY THE CALIFORNIA STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME. THE OLD, TOOTHLESS BEAR QUICKLY BECAME ACCUSTOMED TO THE PEOPLE CARING FOR HIM AND THEREFORE COULD NOT BE RELEASED BACK TO THE WILD. SAMSON WAS SENTENCED TO DEATH.



THE BELOVED SAMSON THE BEAR

WORD QUICKLY SPREAD ABOUT THE PLIGHT OF SAMSON AND THE CAMPAIGN TO SAVE HIM SOON REACHED THE GOVERNOR. GOVERNOR WILSON GAVE SAMSON A STAY OF EXECUTION. MONROVIANS PULLED TOGETHER AND SAMSON BECAME AN INTERNATIONAL CELEBRITY. THE STORY CAUGHT THE ATTENTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY ZOO. MONETARY CONTRIBUTIONS FROM PEOPLE WORLDWIDE PAID FOR AN ENCLOSURE, COMPLETE WITH A HOT TUB, THAT WOULD ALLOW SAMSON TO TAKE UP RESIDENCE AT THE ORANGE COUNTY ZOO UNTIL HIS DEATH OF OLD AGE IN 2001.



WILLIAM MONROE BEAR

IN 2011, AS PART OF THE CITY OF MONROVIA'S 125TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION, THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROGRAM AND LOCAL BUSINESSES PURCHASED EIGHT FIBERGLASS LIFE-SIZE BEARS TO HONOR MONROVIA'S SAMSON. THE BEARS, SEVEN SAMSONS AND ONE DELILAH, WERE UNVEILED AT THE MONROVIA DAY PARADE AND PLACED IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE COMMUNITY. THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROGRAM PURCHASED FOUR ADDITIONAL SAMSONS IN 2017. IN 2020, THE SAMSON PROGRAM WAS IDENTIFIED AS ONE OF MONROVIA'S SIGNATURE ART PROGRAMS. AS SUCH, THE ADOPT A SAMSON PROGRAM WAS CREATED. THE GOAL OF THE PROGRAM IS TO INCREASE AWARENESS OF MONROVIA'S SAMSONS AND ENCOURAGE THE INSTALLATION OF ADDITIONAL BEARS. ADOPT A SAMSON IS AVAILABLE TO ALL LOCAL RESIDENTS, BUSINESS OWNERS AND ORGANIZATIONS BASED IN MONROVIA.


